Great Notebooks, Great Marks

In math class, we will check notebooks and give a mark out of five during each test of the semester. In order to obtain full marks, here is what you need to do:

1) Table of Contents – The table of contents, given by the teacher, must be up to date and complete

2) Titles and Dates Underlined – This is a good habit for any class, and encouraged to be done in red pen with a ruler each day.

3) Notes and Homework Done In Pencil – Each day in math class you should do your work in pencil! It is okay to make mistakes (and erase them), and pencils are the way to go!

4) Three Separate Sections – one section will be notes taken in class, one section will be homework, and the third section will be test/assignments/quizzes. It is also expected here that you will only have math in your binder.

5) General Neatness – your mark will be based on how well your notes look, including having all pages in the binder (no loose papers).

Once you get into good habits, this should be an easy five marks for you. This will go towards the **Communication** mark this semester.
